English

Exploring a quest novel

Students will read, analyse and explore the quest novel *Rowan of Rin* as a class. They will write a short response to explain how the author Emily Rodda represents the main character in an important event in the novel.

Exploring recounts set in the past

Students will listen to, read and explore historical texts including literacy recounts written from different people's perspectives. Students will read a historical recount, *Eliza Bird Child Convict* and answer comprehension questions. They will identify language features used to engage the audience.

Mathematics

HASS (Term 3 & 4)

Australia before, during and after European settlement.

Inquiry question: *What were the short and long-term effects of European settlement?*

In this unit, students will make connections between world history events between the 1400s and the 1800s, and the history of Australia, including the reasons for the colonisation of Australia. They will explore the experiences of Captain James Cook's journey, the First Fleet and aspects that have changed and remained the same and the importance of laws and factors that shape a person's identity and sense of belonging in society.

Science

Material Use

In this unit students will investigate physical properties of materials and consider how these properties influence the selection of materials for particular purposes. They will investigate and apply the observable properties of ochre and relate the properties to their uses in real life situations. Students will complete a report communicating their findings.

Languages

This term, students will be exploring the world of games. Students will have the opportunity to will interact with the teacher and peers in Japanese games, using language of encouragement and reflect on cultural differences.

The Arts: Media Arts (Term 3 & 4)

On the Cover

Students will explore digitisation of magazines on the internet to consider the elements involved to make media artworks and the technologies involved. They will create a magazine cover to communicate ideas about the central character of *Rowan of Rin* discussing how and why they used images, sound and text to make and present their artwork.

Health/HPE

Culture in Australia

Students will investigate how heritage and culture contribute to identity. They will investigate how emotional responses vary and participate in partner/ group activities. They explore communication skills of respect and empathy through the unit and the UR Strong Program to support positive interactions.

PE

Students use the sport of Cricket to demonstrate and refine striking and fielding skills. They apply skills and strategies in active play/games.

Design Technology (Term 4)

ELF Trap

Students will use knowledge and understanding of contact and non-contact forces from Term 4 Science to build an elf trap. They will need to consider materials and factors involved to make a safe and effective snare.
