2026 STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME

In 2026 Morningside State School will again offer parents the opportunity to join the Student Resource Scheme (SRS).

The SRS is supported and approved by the Morningside State School Parents and Citizens Association (P&C) on an annual basis. The purpose of the scheme is to ensure adequate resources are available to provide good quality education to all students, and to save parents and caregivers money and time by allowing them to take advantage of the school's bulk purchasing power for teaching and learning resources.

The cost to join the SRS in 2026 is \$245.00 per child

Whilst participation in the SRS is optional, the school encourages your participation in the scheme, as the best savings for all come from high participation rates. The SRS at Morningside SS operates under the policy and guidelines of Education Queensland. Parents wishing to take advantage of the services provided by the scheme pay an annual fee and sign an agreement to the conditions that apply. Under the guidelines of the Education Act 2006 schools are now able to engage the services of a debt collector if fees fall into arrears.

The participation form you complete will be valid for the entire enrolment period of your child. Each year the school will remind families that they can opt in or out of the SRS by completing another form.

The SRS will supply your child with:

- All stationery required as per their year level booklist
- New technologies classroom computer educational software, apps for iPads and interactive whiteboards to support individualised student learning; online registration for students for various programs e.g. Reading Eggs, Mathletics
- Class sets of atlases, dictionaries, thesaurus and texts to support learning
- Reprographics and expendable materials including printing, art & craft, science equipment,
 classroom consumables

What is not included in the SRS:

 Activities that attract a separate levy for participating students including Instrumental Music, Interschool Sport, Year level camps and any excursions, incursions and emergent opportunities that may arise throughout the year. These invoices are raised throughout the year as the opportunities become available.

What do you need to do?

You do not need to do anything unless you wish to change your option to be part of or withdraw from the SRS. *If you wish to change your option please advise the school by Tuesday 18 November* 2025.

If you opt in:

- Your student will be provided with sufficient resources to allow them to undertake all classroom activities from 27 January 6 February 2026.
- You will be invoiced for \$245.00 per student by the start of Term 1 2026.
 - O By 6 February 2026, payment in full (\$245 per child) or the first of three instalments of \$82 per child must be received for supply of, or access to, resources to continue.
 - For supply of resources to continue, Term 2 payment (\$82 per child) is due by 2 May
 2026.
 - For supply of resources to continue, Term 3 payment (\$81 per child) is due by 25 July 2026.
- Students will supply their own personal items as outlined in their year level book list.
- All school resources loaned to students must be well cared for and returned by due dates set by classroom teachers or Resource Centre staff. Damage or loss will incur a replacement fee.
